Blending mechanical ingenuity, craftsmanship, and heritage, your students will discover how wool was transformed through hydraulic power and traditional know-how.

The Ulverton Wool Mill's educational programming supports learning in connection with the Québec Education Program (QEP):

- Elementary Cycle 1 (Grades 1–2)
 - Discover community heritage and explore science by observing antique machinery.
- Elementary Cycle 2 (Grades 3–4)
 - Place events in time and compare past and present ways of life.
- Elementary Cycle 3 (Grades 5–6)
 - Understand the impact of industrialization and explore hydraulic mechanisms.
- Secondary Cycle 1 (Grades 7–8)
 - Analyze Québec's industrial heritage and its connections with science, technology, and society.
